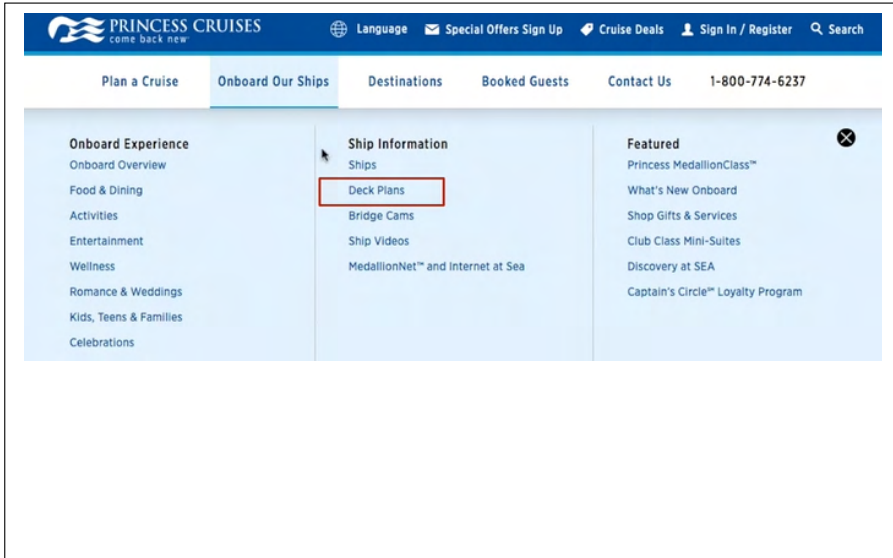
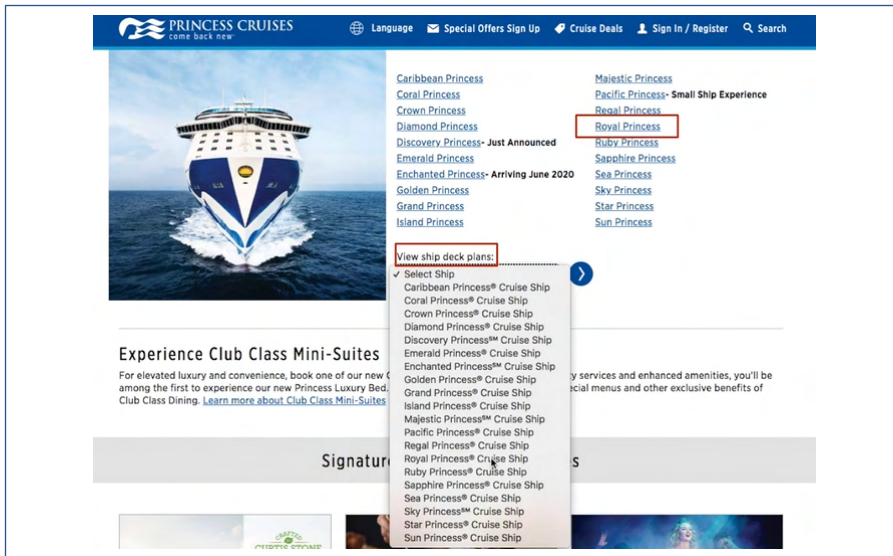


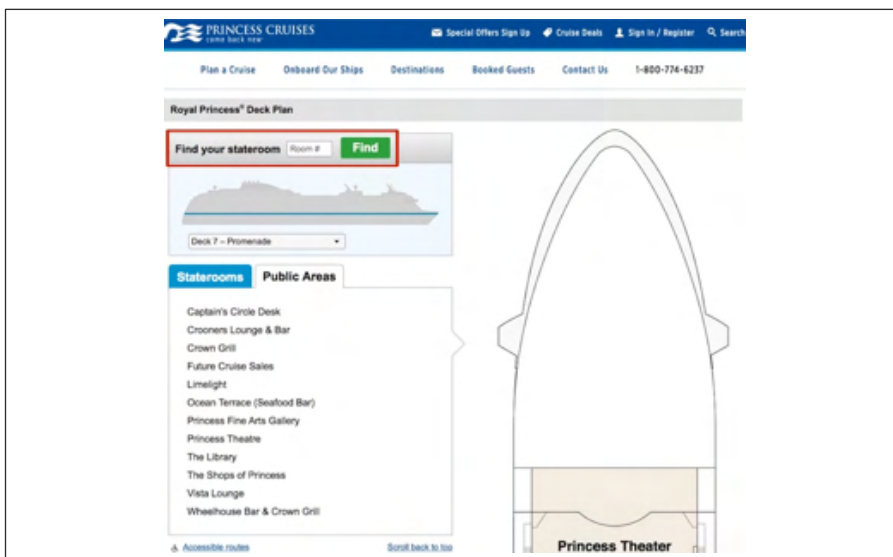
NAVIGATE YOUR WAY THROUGH OUR DECK PLANS



1: From Princess.com, select 'Onboard Our Ships' and then 'Deck Plans'.



2: Select the correct ship name by clicking on the ship name link or by using the drop down menu.



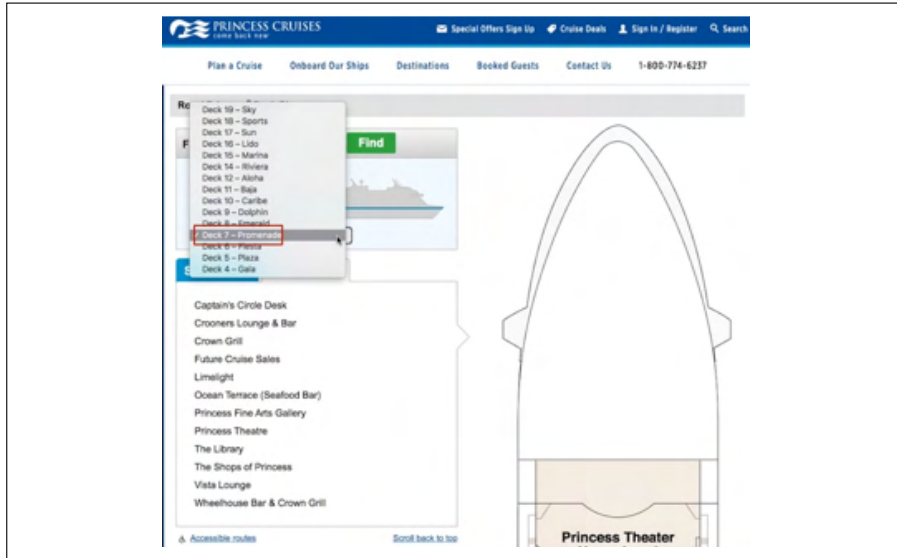
3: Most deck plans open on Deck 7 – Promenade. Deck numbers go up on higher decks and down on lower decks.

Find your stateroom: type in a cabin number to go directly to that deck location.

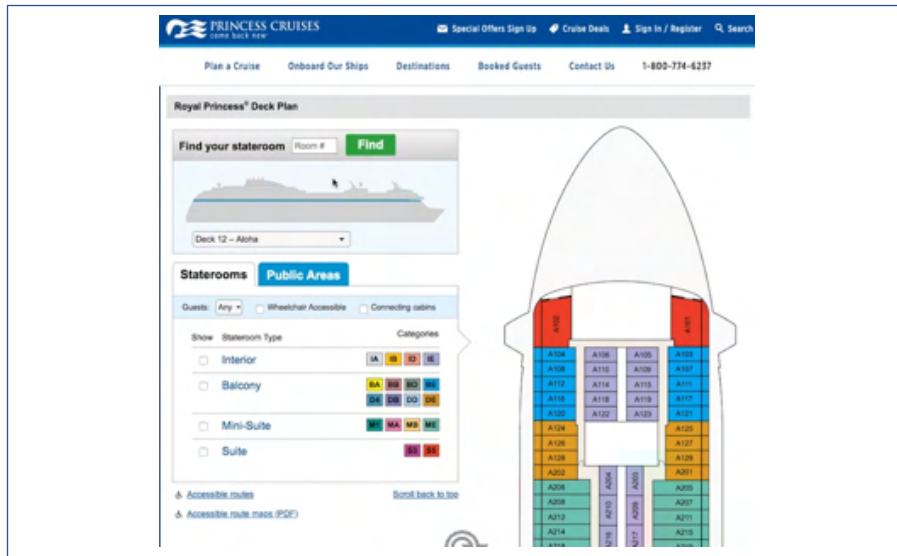

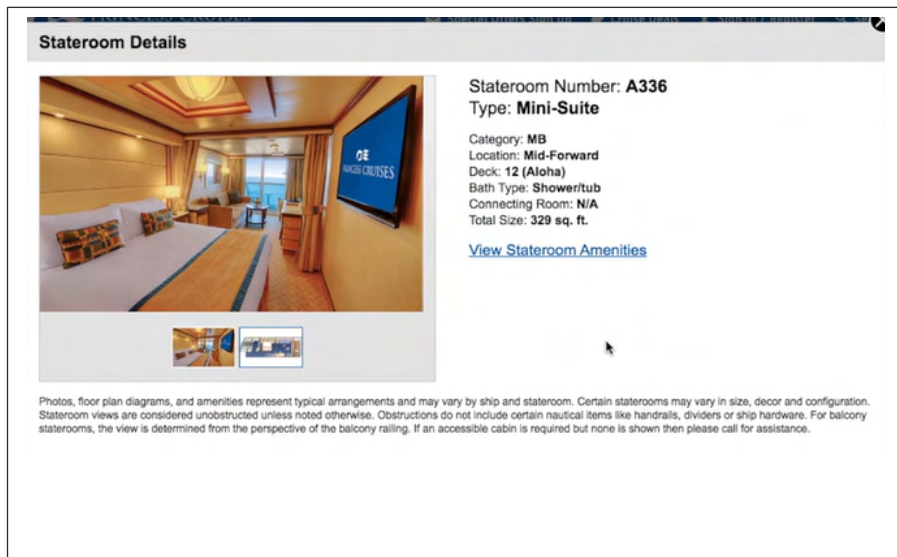

4: You may also select a deck from the drop-down menu.



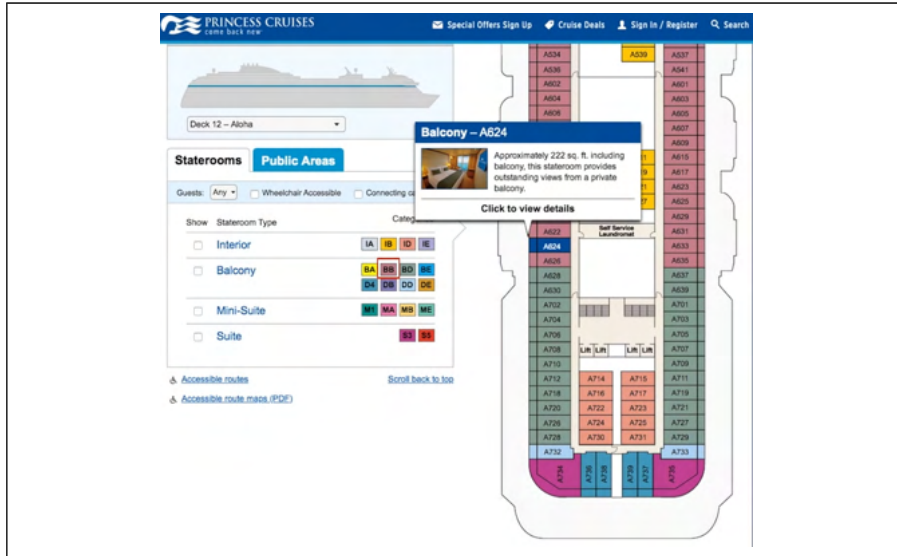
5: Scroll up and down to view the full deck. To zoom in use Control+ or zoom out Control- on your keyboard.



6: Click on a specific cabin and a new window will open with cabin details: category, location, deck, bath type, if there is a connecting room and total size. Special notes such as obstructed view will also be included if applicable.

Note: Photos, floor plans and amenities may vary by ship and all information is subject to change.

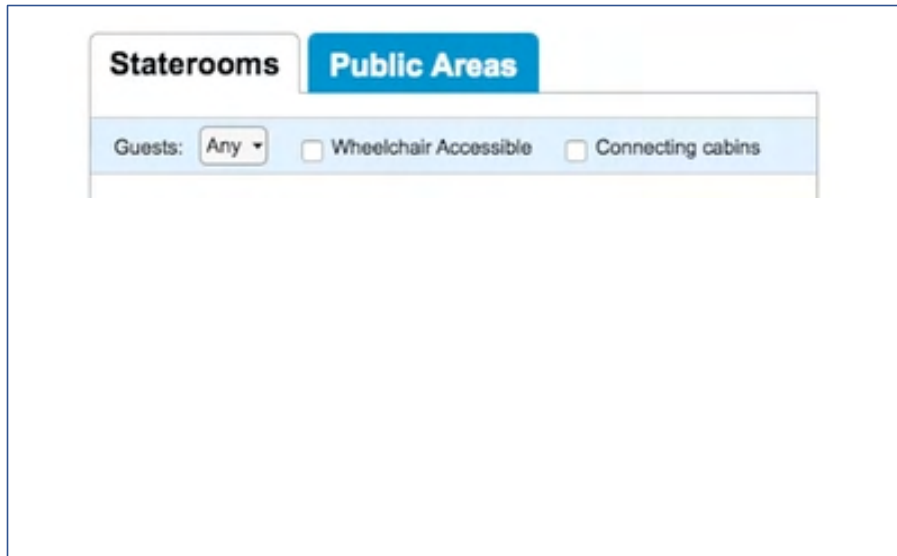

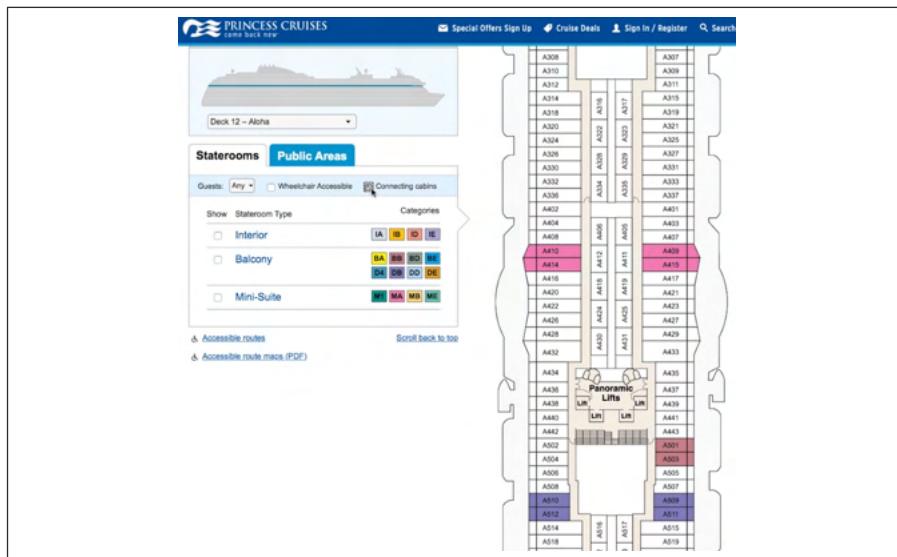
7. Match the stateroom color to the reference guide on the left to determine the stateroom type (interior, balcony, mini-suite or suite).

Note: Even stateroom numbers are on the port side (left) and odd numbers are on the starboard (rights) side of the ship.

Lifts (elevators), stairs and facilities such as the self service laundromat are also shown on the deck plan.



8: The deck plan view may be customized: use the guests drop down to select number of guests in the cabin (up to 4), select wheelchair accessible, or selecting connecting cabins.

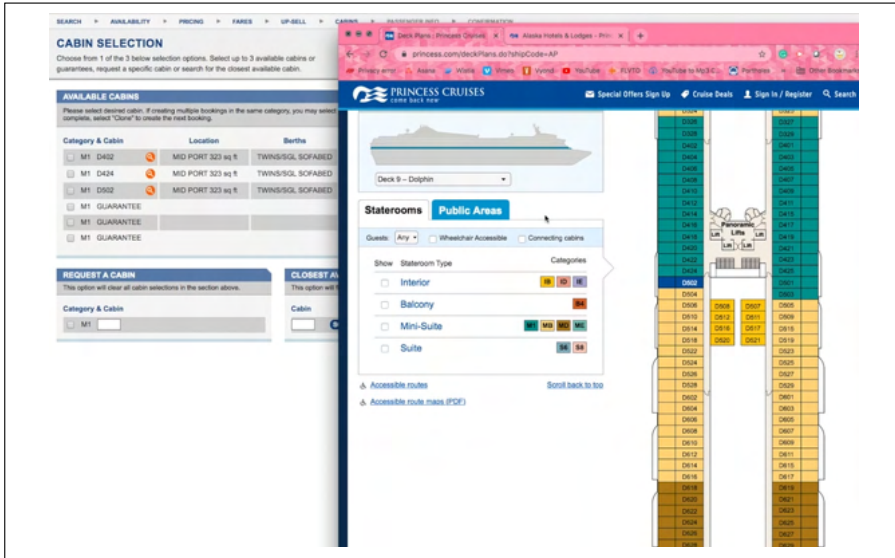


9: After making a selection, cabins that do not meet the selected specifications will appear as white. Here connecting cabins on this deck are in color and non-connecting are white. Scroll up and down to view all of the connecting cabins.

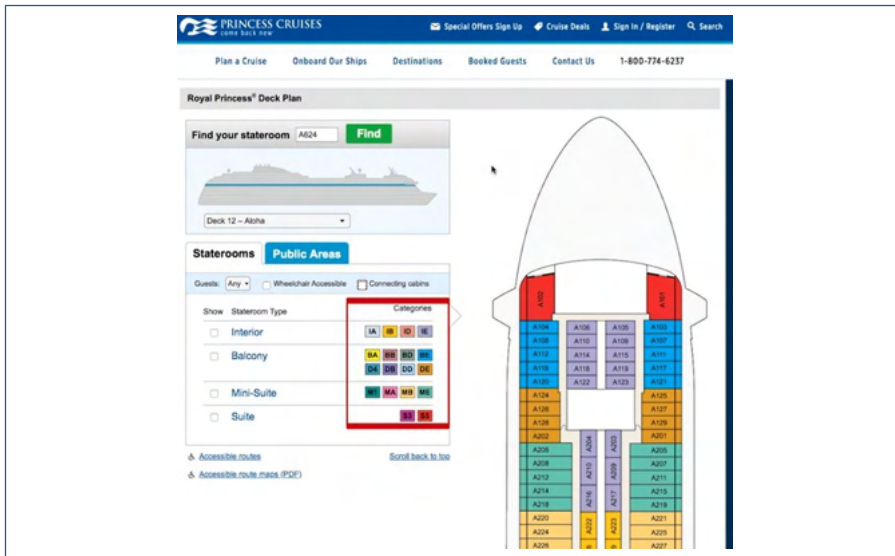

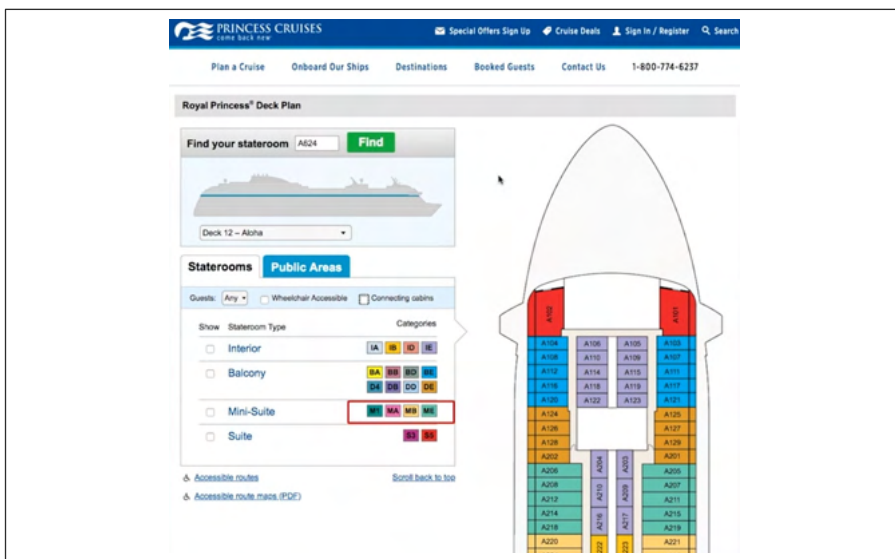

10: During the cabin selection process, best practice is to have a deck plan open to view. In POLAR Online, have the available cabins open to view along with the deck plan to determine cabin location and cabins near each other even across different categories.



11: **Meta:** a group of staterooms or suites that share common, major features. **Category:** a group of individual room styles sharing common features within their meta but varying in size and location on the ship. Each variation is given a unique letter code.



12: Reviewing the mini-suite meta on the Royal Princess, M1 is the highest or best accommodation for a mini-suite and we have MA, MB and ME as the lowest category of mini-suite.
